

## **2012 FARM REQUIREMENTS**

Dear Breeder,

The following is a list of requirements for all horses entering HIGHCLIFF FARM for the 2012 breeding season:

- 1.) CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST TAKEN WITHIN THE PAST TWELVE (12) MONTHS.
- 2.) THE FOLLOWING VACCINATIONS ARE REQUIRED PRIOR TO ENTRY, AND MUST BE UP TO DATE: **INFLUENZA, POTOMAC HORSE FEVER, RHINOPNEUMONITIS, STRANGLES, TETANUS, ENCEPHALITIS, and RABIES.** ANY HORSE ARRIVING WITHOUT MEDICAL RECORDS WILL BE VACCINATED UPON ARRIVAL.
- 3.) HEALTH CERTIFICATE (IF APPLICABLE)
- 4.) A NEGATIVE UTERINE CULTURE IS REQUIRED FOR EACH BREEDING CYCLE BEFORE A STALLION WILL COVER A MARE. IF A UTERINE CULTURE HAS NOT BEEN PERFORMED PRIOR TO ARRIVAL, IT WILL BE TAKEN AT HIGHCLIFF FARM.

HIGHCLIFF FARM reserves the right to continue the vaccination, de-worming, and blacksmith program while the horse resides here.

In addition, please be aware that all board, farrier, and veterinary charges must be resolved before any resident horse will be cleared for departure. We regret having to institute this policy, but due to economic conditions, and the trends resulting from such, we are forced to abide by this policy.

Thank you for your interest in our stallions and for breeding with us. We hope that the above does not inconvenience you in any way, but in order to insure the safety of our stallions, resident horses, and any mare being bred at HIGHCLIFF FARM, we must insist that these requirements be met. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the farm at any time.
